THE WAY BACK:

Jeremiah was called to go to the people of Judah and tell them they had lost their way spiritually. They were far from him and the priests, kings, officials, and prophets were leading the way. However, everyone was responsible and God told Jeremiah to preach the way back to Him.

Ice Breaker:

1. Tell of a time when you were physically lost (while driving, hiking, in a crowd, etc.).
2. What did it feel like to be lost? Was it your fault or someone else's?
3. What did you do to find your way back?
4. If you got help from someone, who was it and what did they do?

Bible Study:

- 1) Jeremiah begins his preaching by reminding Judah of what? **(2:2)** Why did he do this?
- 2) What was Judah's great sin? **(2:5, 2:12-13)**
- 3) Who has helped lead them to this place? **(2:8, 2:26)**

- 4) What does God compare Judah to (3:6-10)?
- 5) What does God tell Jeremiah to proclaim to the people? (3:12-14, 22; 4:1-4)
- 6) What does God say they have refused to do (5:3)? What does the word repent mean?
- 7) What does God promise His people even though disaster is coming? (5:18-19)

Care Time:

1. Do you feel you are following after God right now or have you walked away from Him?
2. What does God say we need to do in those times we have wandered away from Him?
3. Do you need to confess anything to your Missional Community Group, so you can be healed?
4. Who do you know that is in need of biblical community? What steps can you take to include them?
